

Pastor/Missionary Dependent Scholarship

This is available for new and current students.

Unmarried (under 24 years of age) dependents of all full-time Nazarene pastors or associates on the SNU educational region are eligible to receive a \$6,000 scholarship annually. Student must live in one of the university's traditional housing units, and be on a regular meal plan. Full-time Nazarene missionaries are eligible to receive a \$6,000 scholarship annually.

Full-time Nazarene pastors or associates not on the SNU region are eligible to receive a \$4,000 scholarship. The amount will be applied half in the fall and half in the spring semester.

What

Churches of the Nazarene on the SNU Region have a strong partnership with SNU and have, historically, been faithful stewards to give 100% educational support each year.

The Pastors Leadership Scholarship program is an incentive award to our senior pastors in Churches of the Nazarene in Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana and Arkansas.

A \$200 certificate (See example on right) is made available to each pastor for every year they lead their church in 100% giving of their education allocation.
