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Camp Rules:

- A Minimum \$50 fine will be assessed for vandalism, graffiti, or defacement of camp property
- Proper respect for camp facilities, rules, other campers, and staff will be expected of all campers, pranks and bullying will not be tolerated.
- Appropriate attire that emphasizes modesty.
- Swimmers must be covered to and from the pool
- Possession of illegal drugs, firearms, alcohol, or tobacco will result in the suspension from the camp
- The camp is closed to all but registered applicants
- Drivers 18 and under must turn in vehicle keys at registration for the duration of camp due to liability concerns

Cell Phones: Cell phones are allowed on the campground; however, Students are encouraged to not rely on them during the week. We want the students to be engaged with their peers and with the camp activities. Cell Phones should not be used during Worship Services unless instructed to do so by the speaker or leader. Churches are more than welcome to install any cell phone rules for their individual church.

Medical Information: - A Registered Dr./Nurse/Paramedic will be on duty at all times. However, the camp insurance is a supplemental insurance to personal insurance.
